

2008 Zone Shoot Information

There are a number of changes in place for our 2008 zone shoot teams...

There will be 4 teams from each zone; a Men's Team, a Women's Team, a Junior Team and a Veteran Team. These teams will be determined in the Zone Shoot Singles Event.

The Men's Team will be selected from the highest men's score in each of the following 6 classes; AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D. Each zone will select one or more runner-up contestants in each class as alternates to the Men's Team. The contestant with the highest score is the Team Captain.

The Women's Team will be selected from the 5 highest women's scores. Each zone will select 3 or more runner-up contestants as alternates to the Women's Team. The contestant with the highest score is the Team Captain.

The Junior Team will be selected from the 2 highest junior scores, plus the 2 highest sub-junior scores, plus the next highest jr/sub-jr score. The junior alternates will be the next 2 highest junior scores, and the sub-junior alternates will be the next 2 highest sub-junior scores. The contestant with the highest score is the Team Captain.

The Veteran Team will be selected from the 2 highest veteran scores, plus the 2 highest senior-veteran scores, plus the next highest vet/sr-vet score. The veteran alternates will be the next 2 highest veteran scores, and the sr-veteran alternates will be the next 2 highest sr-veteran scores. The contestant with the highest score is the Team Captain.

Special Category shooters must declare, prior to shooting, which team they're trying out for. If they fail to make that declaration, they will automatically be entered in their age-determined special category.

The 4 teams from each zone will compete against each other at the 2008 California State Shoot. This competition will be concurrent with the 200 target Singles Championship event on Saturday, June 28th. The winning teams at the state shoot will receive recognition and additional awards from the CGSTA.

All shooters making a team at the zone shoots will receive a certificate from the CGSTA good for 200 free targets in the Singles Championship event at the state shoot. This certificate is only good if the shooter attends the state shoot and shoots for his/her team. If the shooter does not shoot for his/her team at the state shoot, the certificate will automatically transfer to the alternate who takes their place.
