ATA rules will govern this shoot and all targets will be registered with the A.T.A.

This program has been carefully prepared and the events scheduled and planned in accordance with the conditions and expected attendance. However, the management reserves the right to alter this program if the conditions warrant at the time of the shoot.

Ties for awards will be shot off the day the event is finished, time permitting. When a shoot-off is called, absent contestant forfeits. The scorers will call out the scores after five targets. It is your responsibility to correct any error at that time. The score sheets will not be changed after a round of five has been shot. It is also the shooters responsibility to see that their score is posted correctly on the scoreboard. Shooters winning or tying 16yd class or doubles, advances one class in the next event.

* Ladies, Juniors & Veterans may win only one award per event.

* No shooter will win more than one award in any one event or combined events (excluding buy-in buckles).

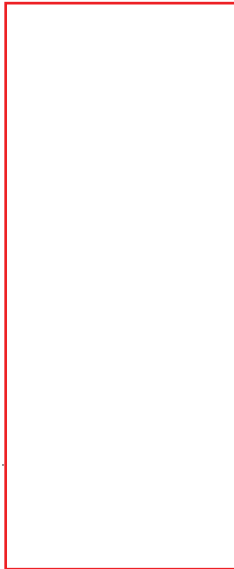
